



## **Student Chapter Presentation Competition ITE Intermountain Section Annual Meeting**

### **Competition Background & Purpose**

This special Student Chapter Competition has been organized to commemorate the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary at the Annual Meeting in Jackson, Wyoming on May 20-22, 2010. Student representatives from each of the four states in the Intermountain Section (Idaho, Montana, Nevada and Utah) are invited to give a presentation on the history of transportation in their respective states. Because Wyoming was once part of the Intermountain Section and because the Annual Meeting is held in Jackson every year, students from the University of Wyoming will also be invited to attend the Annual Meeting and participate in this Student Chapter Competition.

### **Competition Details/Format**

- There will be one presentation for each state. For the states with more than one student chapter, students will have to work together to complete the necessary research and select representatives to give the presentation.
- Each presentation should be approximately ten minutes long, with five additional minutes for questions and answers. Presentations will be included in the Annual Meeting program.
- A projector and laptop computer equipped with PowerPoint will be provided by ITE. Please bring your presentation on a jump drive or CD.
- Each of the participating student chapters will receive a cash contribution of \$100. The group of students selected as the winners of the competition will be recognized with an additional prize during the Awards Lunch on Saturday May 22, 2010.

### **Evaluation Criteria**

The presentations will be judged by a panel of Past Presidents of the Intermountain Section, with one judge representing each state. Evaluation criteria include thoroughness of historical account, creativity of presentation, and professional presentation of material.
