Steve Wylie, Assistant Executive Officer for Metrolink, will describe the Metrolink Sealed Corridor Program, which will enhance the safety and security of over 50 at-grade crossings in Los Angeles County. A Sealed Corridor is a comprehensive strategy to enhance the safety of trains, passengers, motorists, pedestrians, and neighboring land uses within and along a railroad corridor, using appropriate safety measures to systematically reduce the opportunity for accidents at grade crossings or elsewhere within the corridor. Mr. Wylie will discuss what upcoming projects will be constructed and how agencies and consultants can be partners of this program.
