The Highway Capacity Manual (HCM) is a publication of the Transportation Research Board (TRB). Since 1950, the HCM has been a worldwide reference for transportation educators and practitioners. It continues to be one of the most widely used reference manuals in the transportation profession. There have been four editions with improved and updated procedures from 1950 to 2000. The process for development and publication of the 2010 HCM began in 2007 and is currently planned for completion in 2010. This conference session will provide an overview of the many significant improvements that will be included in the 2010 HCM.

The 2010 HCM will contain a number of significant format and content changes. In terms of format, the 2010 HCM is planned to be released as three printed volumes—Concepts, Uninterrupted Flow, and Interrupted Flow—plus an electronic Volume 4 that will contain supplemental material, the HCM Applications Guide, and a Technical Reference Library containing the original research that led to the current HCM methodologies. In terms of content, the 2010 HCM will incorporate the results of over \$5 million in funded research focused on HCM methodologies, including significant updates to several existing HCM chapters and completely new chapters on topics such as Roundabouts, Interchange Ramp Terminals, and Active Traffic Management.
