Engage

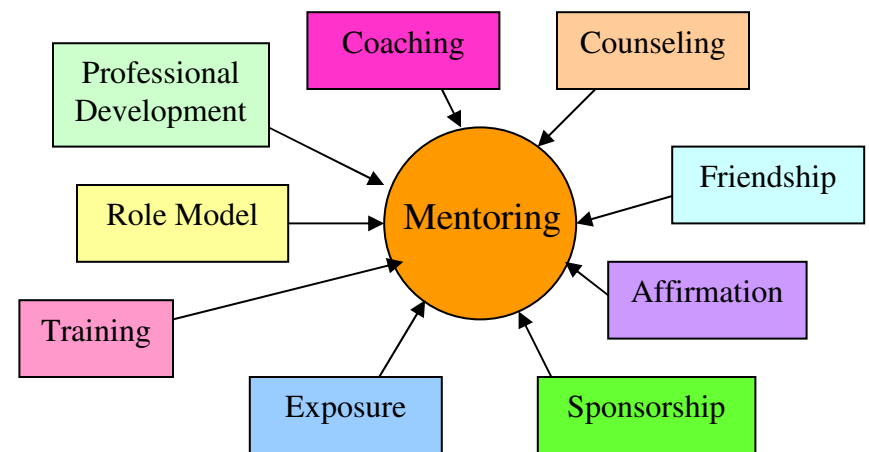
The mentee is a developing junior professional or student, who is paired with a mentor from which to learn and receive guidance.
