District 6 Student Competitions

The following are brief discussions for each of the annual Institute of Transportation Engineers District 6 student competitions. The biggest hint we can give students is that student should consider submitting papers that were already written for some other purpose such as a class assignment. Just make sure to follow the guidelines and rules for each competition. All of the competition rules are posted on the ITE District 6 web page under student services at www.westernite.org.

Student Chapter Award

The purpose of the Student Chapter Award to acquaint Chapter Members with topics of interest in transportation and traffic engineering through the medium of addresses by competent speakers, and of Chapter sponsored trips; to foster the development of professional spirit; to promote common interests among Chapter Members; to encourage the expansion of facilities for transportation and traffic engineering study. **All Student Chapters that submit an annual report receive \$100.** The Student Chapter that submits the Student Chapter Annual Report selected as the most outstanding will receive an additional \$200. Up to two additional Student Chapters may receive \$50 dollars for honorable mention. **The Deadline for Chapter Report submittals is April 1st.**

Student Paper Award

The purpose of the Student Paper Award is to encourage Student Members of ITE to conduct and report on independent and original research and investigation of transportation engineering. The award paper may be published in one or more appropriate publications of the Institute including *WesternITE*. The winner will receive a \$500 cash award, Full Registration and Hotel accommodations for the Annual Meetings, and will be reimbursed up to \$500 for travel expenses. The winning paper will be forwarded to ITE International for participation in International's Student Paper Competition. **The Deadline for Student Paper submittals is April 1st.**

James H. Kell Technical Project Award

The James H. Kell Technical Project Award is a research paper competition as well but it requires original traffic data collection. The Students are encouraged to work in groups and the winning team will receive \$250 for their Student Chapter. **The Deadline for this competition has been extended to June 1st 2002.**
